Eternity

2018 was chaotic: politics got ugly, neighborhoods became unsafe and the entertainment industry went mad, throwing off all sense of morality. We begin 2019 worrying about survival, about politics while watching the entertainment industry continually striving for new moral lows.

There is another view. Bible Believing Christians should view the chaos of 2018 as part of prophecy being fulfilled, (I Timothy 3:12-13). God tells us that our world will get worse; that Satan will increase his efforts to destroy our Christian faith because he knows his time is short, and that all who follow Jesus will suffer persecution, (Revelation 12:12).

I leave the world of 2018 with a song in my head; "Take the world but give me Jesus." The choice is serious. The song compares the joys of the world as "but a name" while Jesus offers eternal abiding love. The rest of the song encourages faith in Him through trusting in His death on His cross. The chorus rejoices in the "height and depth of His mercies" and in the "length and breath of His love." The joy of salvation resounds through the last line, "Oh the fullness of redemption, the pledge of endless life above," (Revelation 21:1-7 & 22:1-8). Many songs exalt our Lord Jesus Christ. This one brings the Christian's choice into sharp focus and that is my interest.

Another song titled "What will you do with Jesus" speaks of our relationship to Jesus saying, "Neutral you cannot be." Being neutral toward Jesus is not an option. Jesus wished the church in Laodicea were cold or hot. He said, "Because you are luke-warm and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth," (Revelation 3:14-16).

Holy God requires commitment to His holiness before entering into His presence, (Matthew 12:30). Thus our eternal situation is hopeless apart from God's mercy, because all of us have sinned against Holy God.

But the great love of God provided a way. Jesus said, "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me," (John 14:6). Praise God, Jesus accepted the cross where His blood flowed from His hands and feet and side washing our sins from us and making us holy and acceptable in His sight.

Thus through the washing in His blood holiness is available to all who seek Him, (John 3:16). Through obeying Him we are invited into His holy presence with confidence [boldness], (Hebrews 4:14-16). To reject Him as Savior and Lord is to suffer the consequences of that action, (Matthew 12:30).

Think about this: what if every day in 2019, every Bible Believing Christian faithfully practiced the faith proclaimed? What difference would our life style make in our community? No, I haven't "quit preaching and gone to meddling." I'm simply pondering verses of Scripture that God gave us. We agree, God doesn't play games with us or waste His time. So, these Scriptures have merit. They are worth our time.

"Seek first His Kingdom and His Righteousness" (Matthew 6:33).
